

Cory Environmental - Milton Keynes & Rushden

From December 2007 through to September 2008, WAMITAB delivered Skills for Life Literacy programmes for Cory Environmental at their depots in Milton Keynes and Rushden. Learners took part in weekly skills development sessions over a 20 week period and were given two hours away from front line duties to undertake their training using WAMITAB developed contextualised learning materials.
