### WAMITAB Level 3 Certificate in Cleaning Service Supervision (QCF 501/1929/1)

#### Qualification summary

This qualification is designed for candidates who are progressing into supervisory, team leading or management roles within the cleaning industry. It can also be applied to wider vocational areas, where candidates undertake cleansing and leadership activities as part of a wider job role.

Candidates must complete a minimum of 27 credits to achieve the qualification.

This should be made up of: 16 credits from Mandatory Group A, a minimum of 5 credits from Mandatory Group B and a further 6 credits (minimum) from Optional Group C.

The qualification provides accreditation to those who are able to demonstrate competence against the occupational standards defined for Cleaning Support Supervision at this level.

**A - Mandatory Group A** - Candidates must achieve a total of 16 credits from this group.  
Credit Value required: Minimum 16.
